## FORM TO DECLINE AID

By filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), the student becomes eligible for several different types of self-help aid. For example, the award may contain Federal Stafford or Perkins Loans, and/or Federal Work Study. The student is not required to accept any of this aid.

Should the student wish to decline any of this aid, the form below should be completed and returned to the Financial Aid Office at 2001 Alford Park Drive, Kenosha, WI 53140. In the alternative, the student can email [finaid@carthage.edu](mailto:finaid@carthage.edu) and specify exactly what aid they wish to decline. We must receive this notification in writing and from the student as the student is an adult and (in reference to the loans) the borrower. Notification from a parent does not satisfy federal regulations. Should a student decline all or any portion of their federal loans, the student can reinstate the loans at any time during the school year by submitting that request in writing. Federal Work Study, however, once declined, may not be able to be reinstated.
