

Guaranteed Admission Agreement Between College of Lake County And Carthage College

College of Lake County and Carthage College agree to a cooperative relationship through this Guaranteed Admission Agreement to better serve students and facilitate the transfer process.

This agreement offers College of Lake County students Guaranteed Admission to Carthage College to complete their Bachelor's degree. Students must meet all of the requirements outlined in this agreement to guarantee their admission to Carthage College.

1. Academic Requirements

- a. Students have completed both ENG 121 and either ENG 122 or ENG 126 with grades of C or higher to meet the English proficiency requirements of Carthage College. Students will not need to submit separate proof of English proficiency at the time of application.
- b. Students must have graduated from high school (as evidenced by a high school diploma or GED) and complete a minimum of 24 transferable credit hours and maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale at the College of Lake County prior to admission to the Guaranteed Admission Program.
- c. Students are expected to meet with the designated transfer advisor at Carthage College to create a personalized plan for transfer credits. This plan will be tailored to the students intended program of study. A maximum of 68 credits can be applied toward a Carthage College degree. Courses accepted for transfer credit must follow Carthage College transfer policies. Additionally, courses numbered lower than 100-level and courses not deemed transferable are not included in this agreement.

2. Admission Requirements

- a. Students must authorize the College of Lake County and Carthage College to disclose their educational records, including but not limited to, academics, admission, financial aid, and advising information as appropriate. By signing the participation form, students agree to allow the two institutions to share information and to allow the student to take advantage of the Guaranteed Admission program of the reverse degree process. Students may also receive communication from Carthage College informing them of presentations, workshops, activities, student events, and visits.
- b. Students must be in good standing at College of Lake County at the time of transfer. Students must adhere to each institution's standard policies and procedures including but not limited to those dealing with admission, enrollment in courses, transfer

credits, financial aid, student conduct and discipline, academic probation, dismissal and reentry.

- c. During enrollment in the Guaranteed Admission Program, Carthage College will provide advisement to students to discuss academic program requirements and transfer credit policies. It is recommended that students track their degree progress by working with their transfer advisor at College of Lake County and Carthage College. Failure to meet with the Transfer Advisor at Carthage College could result in credits which would not applied towards degree completion.
- d. Student are eligible to transfer into more than 40 undergraduate degree programs in the semester format and 4 programs that can be completed in an evening accelerated format at Carthage College. See Appendix A for full list of participating degree programs. The degree programs of Nursing, Social Work, and Education are not included in the agreement. Students wishing to enter these programs should consult their Transfer Advisor for details and applications. International students will not be eligible for evening accelerated programs due to F-1 regulations.
- e. Students may also qualify for Carthage College scholarships. Details about many of these scholarships can be found in Appendix B.

3. Other Terms

- a. Failure to meet the requirements above does not preclude the student from applying and being considered for admission to Carthage College using the traditional admission process.
- b. College of Lake County will publish this document on their website so that the details of this agreement are available to students interested in participating in the program. Carthage College and College of Lake County will have the right to review and approve all advertising for the Guaranteed Admission program.
- c. By means of a separate Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), at the college's request, Carthage College will facilitate the transfer of credit back to the College of Lake County if students transfer to Carthage College before completing an associate's degree. The reverse transfer MOU enables the College of Lake County to award degrees following student transfer.
- d. This agreement is in effect until a mutually agreed-upon change is deemed necessary. Any changes to the program in regards to any part of this agreement, must be in writing so that this agreement can be re-evaluated. Notice of changes shall be provided at least 60 days prior to the first day of instruction (at both institutions) of the academic year in which the change will be implemented.
- e. Should the program be dissolved, students who are participating at that time will be guaranteed transfer into Carthage College provided they satisfy all program requirements.

Appendix B

Carthage College Transfer Student Scholarship Opportunities

The scholarships listed below are as of October 1, 2018 and are subject to change.

Full-time students may qualify for several merit and talent based scholarships ranging from \$4,000 to \$16,000 per year. Many of these no-need Carthage scholarships are awarded immediately upon admission to the College are stackable. The Fall and Spring Scholarship Competitions are not stackable with other Carthage scholarships and/or grants.

Merit-based Carthage College scholarships

Students with a 3.5 or higher GPA will be awarded the Springfield Scholarship of \$16,000.

Students with a 3.0-3.49 GPA will be awarded the Deans Scholarship of \$14,000.

Students with a 2.5-2.99 GPA will be awarded the Faculty Scholarship of \$12,000.

Students with a 2.3-2.49 GPA will be awarded the Carthage Scholarship of \$10,000.

Fall Scholarship Competition

A full-tuition scholarship and an additional scholarship covering 75% of tuition are awarded to 2 new transfer students who show determination, intelligence and motivation. To qualify, candidates must be admitted to Carthage and submit a fall scholarship application to be considered. Carthage will invite finalists to campus for a competition in late spring.

Spring Scholarship Competition

A full-tuition scholarship and an additional scholarship covering 75% of tuition are awarded to 2 new transfer students who show determination, intelligence and motivation. To qualify, candidates must be admitted to Carthage and submit a spring scholarship application. Carthage will invite finalists to campus for a competition in mid-December.

Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) Scholarship

These scholarships are awarded to CLC transfer students with current Phi Theta Kappa membership. This \$3,000 scholarship is in addition to most other merit awards. Proof of Phi Theta Kappa membership may be requested, though there is no separate application for this scholarship.

Multicultural student scholarship

Up to \$3,000 awarded to eligible students. These renewable scholarships are awarded to students of diverse backgrounds. The student must be admitted to Carthage as a new transfer student.
